Pilot Licensing Requirements - Columbia & Willamette River Pilotage Ground – Grade “B”, Grade “A” and Unlimited Licenses

(1) A Grade "B" License issued by the Board authorizes the holder to pilot vessels on the Columbia & Willamette River pilotage ground up to 700 feet L.O.A., except a Grade “B” pilot shall not pilot tankers or vessels with a draft of 38 feet or greater.

(2) To qualify for a Grade “B” license, an applicant must meet the following requirements:

_____ (a) Hold an active Grade “C” license and complete at least 180 days service on the Columbia & Willamette River pilotage ground while holding a Grade “C” license.

_____ (b) Complete at least 30 transits on the pilotage ground piloting ships of between 300 and 600 feet L.O.A.

_____ (c) Complete at least 25 transits on ships 600 feet L.O.A. or greater under the supervision of a minimum of ten different pilots, at least six (6) of whom have held unlimited state licenses for at least five (5) years.

_____ (d) Complete at least five (5) trips in either direction between Astoria and either Longview or Kalama on ships 600 feet L.O.A. or greater under the supervision of an unlimited state-licensed pilot.

_____ (e) Make at least six (6) trips under the supervision of unlimited state-licensed pilots while on the bridge of ships not less than 500 feet L.O.A., with at least three (3) trips in each of the following directions:

(A) From the Willamette River, turning east (upstream) into the Columbia River; and

(B) From the Columbia River upstream of the mouth of the Willamette River, turning south (upstream) into the Willamette River.

_____ (f) Complete at least two (2) trips from dock to dock or anchor to dock while on ships not less than 600 feet L.O.A. while under the supervision of an unlimited state-licensed pilot, with each such trip requiring a 180 degree turn before docking.

_____ (g) Present recommendations from the training course monitor and from at least ten (10) pilots holding unlimited state licenses who participated in the training, certifying that the applicant has sufficient knowledge and shiphandling skills to pilot vessels from and including 600 feet L.O.A. up to 700 feet L.O.A.

_____ (h) The requirements specified in subsections (b), (c), (d), (e), and (f) of this section must have been met during the 180 days preceding application for a Grade “B” license. At the request of the Training Course Monitor and for good cause, the training period may be extended up to 365 days.

10 Signature clarification for “B” license.

In order to obtain the required recommendation from the Training Course Monitor you must ride with at least one member of the CPD Committee. If one or more members of the CPD Committee are among the ten pilots that have signed the ten signatures sheet that satisfies the requirement. If no member of the CPD Committee has signed the ten signatures sheet, then you must have an additional ride with at least one CPD member.

After the CPD member rides with you, he/she reports back to the committee, who votes on whether or not to approve your upgrade. Give yourself time for this to happen. At least 60 days before your license upgrade remind the committee you will need the Course Monitor Recommendation.
